#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Speed Monitoring and Work Zone Speed Control Systems - Daily Calibration and Video Recordings

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a speed monitoring system and a work zone speed  $\mathbf{5}$ control system to undergo a daily rather than an annual calibration check that 6 is kept on file and may be admitted as evidence in certain court proceedings; 7 requiring a speed monitoring system and a work zone speed control system to 8 produce a video recording of every violation for which a certain citation is 9 issued; requiring a certain citation to contain certain information relating to the availability of a certain video recording; and generally relating to daily 10 11 calibration of and video recordings taken by speed monitoring systems and work zone speed control systems. 12
